Transition for Young Adults in Calderdale

In Calderdale Children's Therapy Service are able to assess and treat children until they are 16-19 years old. Discussions regarding transition into adult services will begin from the age of 14.

From the age of 16 years the way young adults access therapy services begins to change. The focus of therapy intervention sometimes moves away from the educational setting and becomes more clinic based. On-going therapy will depend upon the young persons need and clear therapy goals. Patients may be discharged by their Consultant Paediatrician at 16 years depending upon the complexity of their needs. The Children's Therapy Service will continue carrying out access visits and risk assessments in an education setting as long there is support for the intervention to take place.

The Children's Therapy Service will try to ensure a smooth transition into adult services as required. We will aim to liaise with the adult teams and give parents/carers and young adults the relevant information needed.

This is the ideal time to encourage young adults to become more independent and proactive with their therapy needs. We are keen to promote self-management and encourage young adults to take responsibility for their own equipment, orthotics and exercises. Also, adopting a healthy lifestyle by accessing hobbies and sports. As the effect of growth becomes less of an impact on young adults the need for regular therapy assessment reduces.

Adult Therapy Services work very differently to Children's Therapy and they cannot routinely see adults. They can offer assessment and short-term blocks for an acute problem, deterioration or following surgery.

This leaflet aims to give young adults the necessary information on relevant services and contact details.

Therapy

As stated earlier Adult Therapy Teams cannot routinely monitor patients. Instead they will assess and treat individuals with an acute problem for a short-term block of therapy. As young adults there are two options to access physiotherapy services depending upon your needs.

Adult Musculoskeletal Team will accept referrals from 13 years, they are clinic based, specifically treat acute problems relating specifically to joints and muscles and they require a GP referral.
