A photographer is a person who takes pictures



You may need to take off your watch and jewellery



For some photographs you may need to take off some clothes

Taking your photograph



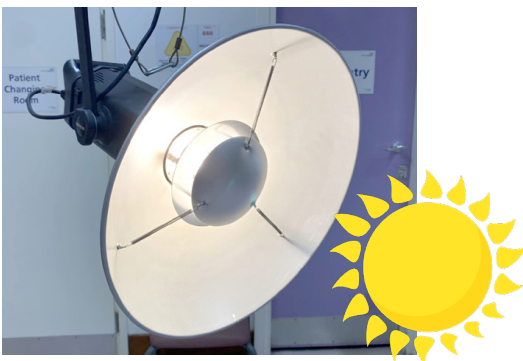
The photographer will make sure you do not feel uncomfortable while they take some photographs



Taking your photos may last around 10 minutes



The photographer will ask you to stand up or sit on a chair



The lights are bright and can feel warm when you are near them



The lights are noisy when they flash



The photographer may have to get close to you to take the photograph



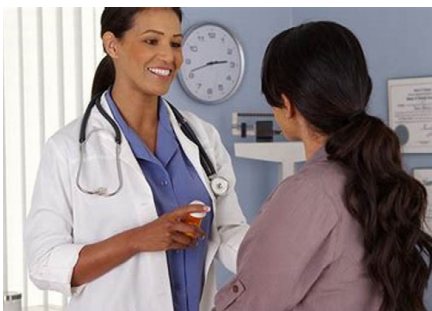
It does not hurt
