What is Parkinsons?

- Parkinsons is a progressive neurological condition.
- Around one person in every 500 has Parkinsons.
- Most people are 50 or over, but younger people can get it.
- Everyones experience of Parkinsons is different.
- People with Parkinsons have lost 80% of their Dopamine, a chemical messenger in specialised nerve cells in the brain.
- Without Dopamine people find their movements become slower and take longer to do things.
- The loss of nerve cells causes Parkinsons symptoms.
- Main symptoms are tremor, rigidity, slowness of movement and loss of balance.
- Although theres currently no cure, there are a range of medicines and treatments available to manage the symptoms of the condition.

Introduction

Parkinsons Disease and Parkinsons related disorders are chronic progressive condition which can affect all aspects of daily life.

Patients and their carers require individual management, specialist care, advice and support. the Parkinsons Specialist Nurse Service will involve patients and their carers in all aspects of decision making.

The Parkinsons Specialist Nurse will support and educate patients and carers to optimise the management of their condition.

Service Aims

- Work with patients to optimise symptom control.
- Plan care involving the patient and family members.
- Act on any changes which may affect the quality of life of the patient and their family.
- Provide education and support for the patient and their family.
- A consistent point of contact for help and support for patients, carers and health care professionals.
- Working with your consultant and GP to optimise your treatment plan.
- To provide information about medication, for new treatments and long term monitoring.

Access criteria

Patient must have a confirmed diagnosis of any of the below:

- Parkinson's Disease
- Multi System Atrophy
- Progressive Supranuclear Palsy
- Lewy Body Disease

What services are provided?

The Parkinsons Specialist Nurse provides a Nurse Led Clinic Service in the hospital and in the Community.

- Newly diagnosed clinics, providing counseling, education and support.
- Telephone Clinics for Medication reviews.
- Home Visits (as appropriate).
