☐ **You have had IV sedation therefore you must:**

- Have a responsible adult to care for you at home for 24 hours
- Have plenty of rest at home as the sedative can make you feel lethargic and tired

You must not:

- Drive a vehicle or motorcycle
- Drink alcohol, take recreational drugs or sleeping tablets
- Operate machinery or household equipment (kettle /cooker)
- Sign any legal documents
- Look after young children and dependents

- **You must not drive or operate machinery** for 30 mins since last use

☐ **You had nothing** you can continue as normal immediately

If you have had biopsies/tissue samples the results will be available in 6-8 weeks. **These will not be available from the endoscopy department.**

However, this may be sooner if you are on a fast track suspected cancer pathway. Once the consultant has the biopsy results they will write to you or you will be invited to a clinic appointment.

After your procedure you may experience:

- You may have some bloating or stomach cramps or a feeling of fullness due to the air we put in during the test. This usually settles within a few hours, if not peppermint tea and walking about may help.
- You may notice some spotting of blood on the toilet and/or tissue which will settle.
- If blue dye spray was used this may show up in bowel motions for 24 hours.

Things to watch out for:

- Severe pain in the neck, chest or abdomen
- Large amounts of bright red blood or black motions
- Fever
- Vomiting

If you develop any of the above please seek medical advice from:

- **GP** in working hours
- **111** out of hours or for urgent advice the nearest **A&E** department
