# Paediatric fasting guidelines for children and babies having surgery in the morning



It is very important that these instructions are followed otherwise the operation may be cancelled.

**Children can have food/milk up until 3.00 am**  
**Children can have clear fluids until 8.00 am**  
(please see details below)



### Food / Milk

- Food may be eaten and Milk drunk up until 3.00 am  
This includes all foods, cows milk and formula milk.  
No food or milk (except breast milk) should be taken after 3.00 am

**Babies less than 1 year old must be woken and fed (formula milk between 2-3 am; breast milk between 4-5 am).**

**Breast milk is allowed up until 5.00 am.**

This is when the feed must finish not start.

Young babies should be woken up during the night and offered a feed (finish by 5am).

### Drinks

Children and babies coming into hospital early in the morning (usually about 7.30 am) for an operation during the morning can only drink

**Clear fluid up until 8.00 am (1hour pre-op)**

Clear fluid means either water, or **diluted** fruit cordial or squash.

Please offer this to your child before 8.00 am and encourage them to have a drink. Then nothing to eat or drink after 8.00 am.

Children should be offered a drink on the ward on arrival up to 8.00 am.

Sips of clear fluid are allowed up until the time of sending for theatre.

## The following are **not** allowed:

- Fruit juice / fruit shoots (too concentrated)
- Cloudy drinks, or drinks containing pulp or bits
- Fizzy drinks
- Fruit smoothies
- Milk (of any sort)

## Medicines

- All morning medicines should be taken as normal, unless otherwise directed. These can be taken with water only (ie not with yoghurt or other foods)

## Sweets and Chewing Gum

- No sweets or chewing gum are allowed on the day of surgery until after the operation
