Children going home after dental surgery



How long will it take my child to recover?

It may take your child up to a week to recover fully from their operation. During this time your child should stay away from school or nursery. Make sure your child has things to do but allow for periods of rest. Your child should not participate in any sport or anything energetic for 24 hours to avoid the socket bleeding.



Is there anything I should be aware of?

Some slight oozing may occur but if there is bleeding, get your child to bite on a piece of gauze or tissue or a clean handkerchief, keeping the wad in place for 20 minutes. Stay with the child to ensure that the wad does not become dislodged, thereby causing a choking hazard. Repeat if necessary. If the socket continues to bleed please contact the Day Surgery Unit or Ward 3 on the numbers provided in this leaflet. If unable to contact Day Surgery or Ward 3 then please call NHS 111.

What about eating and drinking?

Give your child light meals and lots of fluids for a few days. Plenty of drinks and, after the first day, using mouthwashes after meals will help keep the mouth clean and speed up the healing. please avoid mouthwashes and hot drinks for the first 24 hours as these may increase the risk of bleeding.

What if my child has some pain?

If your child has discomfort give Paracetamol and Ibuprofen. Follow the instructions on the bottle or pack. If the pain relief you have been advised to give is not helping the pain, please contact the Day Surgery Unit or Ward 3 for advice.

Brushing your childs teeth

You can start brushing your childs teeth as normal the day after surgery. This helps the socket to heal and prevents infection.

Will my child need another appointment?

Yes. You may be given an appointment before your child goes home or your child may be followed up at the dentists.
