

# How will my child be feeling?

Your child will probably feel some discomfort for up to a week after the operation, but it can take longer depending on each child.



# How long will it take my child to recover?

- It may take your child up to a week to recover fully from their operation.
- During this time your child should stay away from school or nursery.
- Make sure your child has things to do but allow for periods of rest.
- On return to school, let the school know that your child should not do P.E. or join in rough games for three to four weeks.
- No swimming for 2-4 weeks or until fully healed.

# What if my child has some pain?

If your child has any pain or discomfort, give Paracetamol or Ibuprofen. Make sure that you follow the instructions on the bottle or pack. The nurse will advise you on when and how to give the medication.

#### What about the stitches?

- The wound from the operation has a light elastoplast dressing covering it.
- The stitches underneath are dissolvable. They take about two weeks to dissolve.
- There may also be some steristrips (thin white strips) over the wound.
- There will also be a small wound on the scrotum which has also had dissolvable stiches, this will have been covered with a clear dressing spray.
- The wound needs to be kept dry for two or three days, after which the child may have a bath.
- If there are steristrips over the wound, they can be soaked off in the bath. The wound does not need to be re-covered with another dressing after bathing.



# Will my child need another appointment?

Your child will need a follow up appointment. Your child will be sent an appointment in the post or via a phone call.
