The environmental visit has been completed on behalf of the Vascular therapy service at Bradford Royal Infirmary. The purpose is to assess the property for its suitability to enable your relative/friend to return home to the property wheelchair based following their recent surgery/in advance of any proposed surgery. This will involve assessing if the property is suitable for downstairs living (including single room living with bed downstairs and commode). Please be aware that today's assessment is to support discharge planning and is not an assessment regarding major adaptations to the property.

The environmental visit report and photographs taken today will be sent onto the Vascular therapy service at Bradford Royal Infirmary for them to use the information and make recommendations to plan for your relative or friend's discharge from hospital. Any questions regarding discharge planning can be discussed with the Vascular Therapy service; they can be contacted you by phoning the vascular ward or they may contact you directly to discuss the outcome of today's assessment.

Patients may be referred to the community rehabilitation team on discharge from hospital following vascular surgery or amputation. They deliver pre-operative home visits, access visits and rehabilitation for patients who require prosthetic limb assessment and those who are not suitable for prosthetic limb assessment.
