Building Early Sentences Therapy

What is it?

Building Early Sentences Therapy (BEST) is an **early language** group which supports children to **understand** and **produce** sentences. The programme focuses on 'learning through **listening**', using multiple **repetitions** with adult and peer modelling, as well as **visual** supports - using toys and signing.

How is it run?

This is a **small group** intervention, typically with up to 6 children per group, run by a speech and language therapist supporting two therapy assistants.

The children invited to this group are between the ages of **3-6** years old.

Each child is invited to **8 clinic sessions** initially with a potential further 4 sessions after the reassessment point.

Why will it help?

The children targeted by this therapy group may only be using single words or 2-3 word phrases. They may also have a limited vocabulary or difficulty understanding spoken language. This intervention aims to support your child to produce simple sentences although there is no expectation for them to do this until they are ready. Developing a child's early vocabulary and sentence structures can encourage other areas of a child's speech and language as well as educational and social development.

We encourage you to attend all sessions to ensure your child is able to access the full benefits of this programme.

What do I do next?

Following the intervention, your child will either be handed back to the caseload holder or discharged as appropriate.

Your care plan will detail the child's specific targets for the group.

To continue to generalise the skills worked on in these sessions, you should:

- Complete the weekly homework sheets to practice the sentences with your child.
- Model simple language throughout your daily routines e.g., "Mummy is eating" (child) is putting shoes on" "open the door" "Daddy help" to increase exposure to functional words and phrases.
