Advice following Oral Surgery

Please Remember

- Take care until the numbness has worn off.
- Be careful not to bite your tongue, lips or cheeks.
- **Avoid** - Spitting, rinsing and hot drinks / food for the next 24 hours.
- Avoid smoking and vaping - for a minimum of the next 2 days. Smoking and vaping can dramatically increase the risk of poor healing, pain and infection.
- Healing is quicker if the wound is kept clean. To do this **do not rinse today**, but start tomorrow using warm salt water (one teaspoon of salt in half a glass/cup of water), rinsing gently after meals for the next week or so.

Bleeding

- This should be minimal after surgery, though blood-stained saliva in the mouth is totally normal for 48 hours after surgery. You may notice a red patch on your pillow the morning after surgery.
- Bleeding may start again if you disturb the wound, spitting or rinsing the mouth in the first 24 hours are common causes of bleeding.
- If bleeding starts again, make a firm pad by rolling a clean handkerchief or gauze. Dampen this with water or saline and place this over the area which is bleeding, bite firmly for 20 minutes without disturbing the pad.
- If bleeding continues after this, contact the department or your dentist. Out of hours contacts are below, alternatively call 111.
- Avoid alcohol, smoking and excessive exercise for 24 hours after surgery.

Swelling

It is quite normal to experience some swelling of the face after an operation in the mouth, this is usually worst one to two days after surgery, then resolves over the next 2-3 weeks. An ice pack held outside the mouth over the area in the first few hours after surgery may help reduce this.

Pain

Once the local anaesthetic wears off it is usual to feel discomfort.

Pain tends to be worse on the 2nd or 3rd day but gradually improves over a period of 10-14 days. Simple painkillers such as Paracetamol, Ibuprofen or Co-codamol (codeine and paracetamol) should control the pain. Avoid ibuprofen if you are asthmatic, have acid reflux or are currently also taking aspirin. If in doubt, ask your pharmacist for advice on what you can take.

If there is a sudden increase in pain after the first few days, this may indicate infection, in this case please contact the department.

Do not worry if you feel small fragments of bone. These are the edges of the tooth socket and will disappear as your mouth heals.

Oral Hygiene

The next day, start using salt water mouth rinses. Repeat gently rinsing 4 or more times daily and especially after meals, this will help healing. Keep your teeth clean with gentle tooth brushing. Chlorhexidine (Corsodyl) mouthwash will help reduce plaque while tooth brushing is difficult.

Diet

Your mouth opening will be restricted for about a week. Eating softer food should be possible. Use your own discretion and gradually start eating normally according to your own pace.

Stitches

Sometimes stitches may be required. These usually dissolve in 7-10 days.
