A Myringoplasty is an operation to repair a perforated ear drum.

How long will it take my child to recover?

It will probably take around 5 to 7 days for your child to fully recover from the operation. It will be necessary to keep your child away from school and nursery for at least one week.

Your child should:

- Rest today and gradually increase their activities as they seem able.
- Renew the cotton wool plug in your child's ear whenever necessary ... but do not attempt to remove any dressing from the ear canal ... if this appears to be insecure and/or falling out, snip any excess off with a clean pair of scissors never force it back into the ear canal.
- Keep their ear dry for 2 weeks this includes the sutures behind the ear, which may be dissolvable
 or to be removed.
- Avoid smoky atmospheres and people with coughs and colds.
- Avoid swimming altogether until told otherwise.
 (Approximately 6 weeks)
 Avoid any activity which involves sudden changes in air pressure e.g. flying, until the Doctor has said it is safe to do so.
- Do not let your child blow their nose hard over the next 2 weeks as this could displace the ear drum.



Will my child need any medication?

If your child has any pain or discomfort, give Paracetamol. Follow the instructions on the bottle or pack. The nurses will advise you when and how often to give the pain relief. If the pain does not go away, seek medical advice.

Will my child need a follow-up appointment?

Your child will be given an out-patients appointment before going home, or one will be sent in the post. Your child will usually see the doctor in 2-3 weeks.
