

Urology Specialist Nurse Service

Service overview

The Urology Specialist Nurse supports people with Urological Cancers /Diseases and specialises in their care.

We work closely with your Doctors and others who will be looking after you during your hospital visit, to ensure you receive the best care and support available for your specific condition.

The role of the Specialist Nurse/Keyworker

The Urology Specialist Nurse/Keyworker specialises in the care and support of patients diagnosed with a Urological Cancer.

The role is to provide a point of contact from diagnosis through investigations and treatment.

There is a team of specialist Nurses covering all Urological Cancers, cross cover is provided at Huddersfield Royal Infirmary and Calderdale Royal Hospital when staff are on Annual Leave.

- Most Consultant Clinics are attended by Urology Specialist Nurses to support patients receiving a new diagnosis of Cancer.
- We liaise with the Consultant regarding planning of your care and/ or to discuss urgent issues.
- Are members of the local Multi- Disciplinary Team meetings which are held weekly.
- A member of staff attends the Bradford Multi- Disciplinary Team meeting weekly.
- We organise rehabilitation following Radical Prostate Surgery.
- We provide advice and support to patients/carers.
- We meet Information needs and help patients to be in control of their own decisions.
- We keep GP'S aware by letter with a copy sent to the patient.
- We encourage awareness of Urological Cancer and screening.

Service aims

As a key member of the urology team we aim :

- To ensure that all aspects of practice are directed to meeting the needs and interests of patients.
- To continually develop the service for Urology Patients in conjunction with the objectives of the Trust.
- To minimise waiting times for consultations and treatments making the most of the hospital services available.
- To act as a source of information for patients/carers and health care staff on Urology Cancers and treatments.

How can I help you and your family?

Finding out you have Cancer can be a worrying time. You may have concerns or questions and to help you through this time I am your Specialist Nurse/Keyworker.

I can provide an opportunity to talk about:-

- Your diagnosis, potential treatments and management.
- How your diagnosis is affecting both you and your family's life acting as an advocate to promote and facilitate quality and individualised care.
- Any investigations you are due to have.
- Offer advice about how you can contact the other specialist services if appropriate to your needs e.g. social worker, benefits advice, counselling and support groups.
- Adjusting to life after Cancer can be difficult so you may need help resuming your normal routine after treatment.

Multi-Disciplinary Team Meeting (MDT)

MDT

As your Key worker I will be involved in a meeting to discuss your care and best treatment plan. At this meeting the Consultants, Doctors, Pathologists, Radiologists, Oncologists and Urology Specialist Nurses, will be present looking at your results and any scans/ x-rays you have had to obtain your diagnosis and staging. There is a local MDT at Huddersfield and central MDTs either at Bradford or Leeds. You are usually discussed at both the local and central MDT'S. A plan of action is agreed regarding the best available treatment options.

Investigations

These will normally take place in either Huddersfield or Calderdale Royal Hospital. These will be tailored to your needs.

Treatment

Surgery would normally be performed in Bradford.

Radiotherapy is usually performed at St. James Hospital Leeds however you will be seen in Bradford to discuss the treatment options.
