

Having an Ultrasound Scan






You are coming for an ultrasound scan.




At the main reception someone can show you the way to the x-ray department.

This is where ultrasound is.



You should have a card or letter to bring with you.



Give the card or letter to the x-ray receptionist.



You can sit in the waiting room until it is your turn.



You might have been asked to not eat anything before you come.



You might have to drink some water before your scan too.



You will be asked to lie on a couch.



You will probably need to lift your clothes up a little bit so they can put some gel on your skin.



Your scan could take 10 minutes.



Sometimes they can take up to 45 minutes.





After the scan is finished you can wipe off the gel with some paper.



They will tell you when you can go.



You will get your results from the doctor who asked you to come.
