

Orthopaedic Department

Advice regarding outpatient follow-up following attendance with a fracture (broken bone)

Your injury has been assessed and treated by the Emergency (A&E) Department staff.

Following this review in the Emergency Department there are two possible outcomes:

- 1. General fracture clinic appointment
- 2. You will be referred to the Virtual Fracture Clinic (VFC)

What happens in the VFC?

- The Virtual Fracture Clinic Team will contact you by phone within the next few days to confirm a plan of management and provide further information even if no follow-up is thought to be required.
- Clinics are scheduled Monday to Friday and led by a Consultant Orthopaedic Surgeon. Your injury and relevant x-rays will be reviewed electronically to decide your management plan.
- Many injuries heal well over time without any further treatment. However, if it is felt necessary, a specialist appointment will be arranged for you.
- Any information will be confirmed in a subsequent letter to you/your GP.

It is important that we have current contact details for you, including at least one phone number.

You should expect a phone call within 72 hours after presentation to the hospital. If we are unable to contact you a short message or text will be sent asking you to contact the VFC. If you do not receive a phone call or message after the 'contact day' please contact the VFC.

Please be aware that phone calls made from within the hospital will appear on your phone as "number withheld"
