

Starting your Cancer Treatment at Huddersfield Royal Infirmary/ Calderdale Royal Hospital Information for patients/carers/relatives

This leaflet explains what happens when you have been referred for treatment.

After seeing the Consultant

Your Consultant may just have explained and discussed with you your specific cancer treatment. You should have been given a written information sheet regarding this and it would be helpful if you could read this prior to your pre-assessment appointment/treatment appointment.

There are various reasons why a pre-assessment may not be offered, if that happens you will still receive all relevant information regarding your treatment and its side effects when you attend for your appointment.

What will happen during this visit?

A chemotherapy nurse will discuss your treatment in more detail and provide you with a date of when you will be starting your treatment if you haven't been told this already. It is important that you attend the pre-assessment clinic as it allows us to meet you personally and to provide and prepare you with all the information you need before you commence your treatment.

Please write down and bring with you any questions or concerns you may want to discuss with us. You will have the opportunity to ask any questions and discuss any anxieties you may have. Please bring a list of any medications you are currently taking.

If you require a semi permanent line for your treatment the nurses will arrange this for you

A number of pre-treatment tests may be required:

- Blood Tests
- Blood Pressure
- Temperature
- Pulse
- Height
- Weight
- MRSA Screening
- ECG
- ECHO

Please purchase a thermometer before starting treatment, these are available from pharmacy for around £3 each.

Moisturising creams are available over the counter for you to buy or we can prescribe them if required to protect your skin during treatment.

Please ask the nurses about any dental treatment or holiday vaccinations prior to starting your treatment.

You should have received a parking permit that is valid for one year whilst you are undergoing treatment, if you have not been given a permit please ask one of the nurses, these can be used at both HRI and CRH.

On the day of your treatment

You will be sat in a chair, in a room with other patients. You are welcome to bring a friend or relative to sit with you during your treatment. Please be advised that due to limited space we politely request a maximum of two visitors per patient. It is also advisable not to bring small children or babies to the unit for infection and health and safety reasons/risks.

If you are here over the lunchtime period soup and a sandwich will be provided. You are welcome to bring books, kindles, iPads etc. Free Wi-Fi is available. There are also ipads available for patients use. Please ask a nurse if you would like one. Please provide your own headphones.

Please wear your normal clothes. If you are scalp cooling you may want to wear warmer clothes or bring extra layers.

Where to go?

Prescriptions

Please take any prescriptions we give you to the pharmacy on the Ground floor at HRI/CRH in the main entrance, our prescriptions can only be dispensed by our in house pharmacy.

Blood tests at HRI/CRH

The Pathology lab at **HRI** is located on the ground floor through the Costa Coffee Shop

You can book a blood test in the lab at a time that suits you or if you prefer you can ask your GP surgery or District Nurse to take a sample.

X-rays at HRI & CRH

Our X-ray departments are located on the 1st Floor at Calderdale Royal Hospital and Lower Ground Floor at Huddersfield Royal Infirmary, please follow the signs.

CT, MRI, Ultrasound

Your appointments for CT, MRI or Ultrasound will come in the post and directions will be on the letter you receive.

ECG and ECHO at HRI & CRH

ECG tests and ECHO tests take place in the Cardiology Department which is located on the ground floor at CRH and the 2nd floor at HRI.
