The Oncology and Haematology 24 hour Emergency Helpline is for problems related to your treatment or your cancer.

Chemotherapy and other treatments related to your cancer are known to have unpleasant side effects. Some of which include pain, nausea, vomiting, tiredness, constipation, diarrhoea, sore mouth, loss of appetite, feeling generally unwell, infection, sore hands and feet.

It is IMPORTANT to recognise these symptoms early and it is vital to contact us on the helpline which is a 24 hour service - 7 days a week.



Nursing Professionals

The 24 emergency helpline is run by Acute Oncology/Haematology Specialist Nurses and Doctors.

What the service provides

The aim of the helpline is to provide appropriate and timely access to specialist advice and treatment when experiencing urgent problems.

When ringing the HELPLINE

When ringing the helpline, if possible please can you have all personal details such as your hospital number to hand as you will be asked a variety of questions, some of these questions may not seem relevant but are important for us to triage effectively. This will help the nurse to assist you in a timely manner.

If the phone goes to voice-mail please leave your name and contact number and the nurse will ring you back, this will be on the same day. However, if it is an emergency please ring 999.

Where the unit is based

The Emergency Helpline is a 24 hour service which is based at Huddersfield Royal Infirmary (HRI). This can be confusing due to Calderdale number provided but the unit is based at HRI not CRH.

Attending the unit

The nurse may ask you to attend the unit and to be assessed for further investigation. Please bring an over night bag and any medications you are taking, just in case you need to be admitted.

Emergency Advice

Please ring the helpline before attending A&E unless your are calling with: chest pain, severe shortness of breath, excessive bleeding or collapse please call 999 urgently

If your temperature is 37.5°C or ABOVE or BELOW 36°C please ring the helpline for URGENT review.

For Non-Emergency enquiries eg: transport, appointments and information regarding your diagnosis, please contact your key worker (specialist nurse) or the chemotherapy outpatients department, who will be able to assist you.

The helpline is not a drop in service and you must ring to be telephone triaged and you will be given an appointment.
